Question:

Clause 6.5 EN ISO 18526-3 : 2020 requires evaluation using two trained observers .

Table 21, page 33 EN ISO 16321-1:2022 specifies the quantity to be assessed as “1”.

How many samples should be assessed?

Solution:

The quantity to be assessed should be 2 specimens, one specimen for each trained observer.
