<p>Question:</p> <p>How should it be determined whether a product is a goggle or not?</p>		
<p>Solution:</p> <p>If a manufacturer states that a product is a goggle and the product comply with the definition (goggle) of EN ISO 4007, the laboratory should treat it as such.</p> <p>However, the laboratory should not apply special provisions when testing such products. The products should satisfy the requirements when the tests are performed as for a 'conventional' goggle.</p> <p>Rationale:</p> <p>Increasingly, products exist that cross over the traditional design boundaries between spectacles and goggles. If the product satisfies the claimed performance when tested, the actual description of the product should not be important.</p>
